

### ***Another Successful ECCE***

The recently concluded IEEE Energy Conversion Congress & Expo (ECCE 2019), drew 1829 registered attendees to the Baltimore Convention Center, September 29-October 3. Participants from academia, industry and research institutions enjoyed an extensive program consisting of 18 tutorials, 18 special sessions and 1069 technical papers spread across 153 oral sessions and 20 poster sessions plus five plenary session talks.
